We even have two "Cat Advoocates" - staff members who ensure that our cat friendly standards are adhered to, and who are happy to talk to you about your cats needs.

What does the Cat Friendly Clinic mean?

We are **Gold Standard** accredited, which means we can give you peace of mind and reassurance, letting you know that we have reached top accreditation standards.

It means we have built and organised our clinic with our feline friends in mind, and we're more than happy to show you around the clinic to see our wonderful facilities.

Specifically:

We have additional requirements in our waiting room - such as space for carriers to sit off the floor.

We have a separate cat ward with larger cage sizes.

We have a dedicated cat consult room, with half hour appointments.

We have our own operating theatre - separate from our treatment area.

We have high level equipment at our disposal - from radiography and imaging to pathology.

We are trained to handle cats respectfully and gently - we've taken the No Scruff pledge!
